EMERGENCY FIRST AID PROCEDURES

Administer large volumes of lime water or weak calcium chloride solution. Five strong coffee and aromatic spirits of ammonia as stimulants. Artificial Respiration if needed. Keep warm. Call physician who should give digitals hypodermically and 10 grams of calcium gluconate intravenously.

SEEK PROMPT MEDICAL ATTENTION FOR EYE CONTACT OR INGESTION
IF ANY SYMPTOMS PERSIST CONSULT A PHYSICIAN.

Natural Animal Herbal Powders are thought to be stable. Hazardous polymerization will not occur.

Section VII - WASTE DISPOSAL, ENVIRONMENTAL & SPILL PROCEDURES
