Section V – Health Hazard Data

Threshold limit value: Unknown

Cedar Spray is thought to be stable.

Cedar Spray is incompatible with strong concentrated oxidizing agents and acidic agents. Hazardous polymerization will not occur.

Cedar Spray is not flammable and Non-Hazardous

Section VII – Waste disposal, Environmental & Spill Procedures

Ecozone Cedar Spray is **Biodegradable**. Small amounts may be flushed into sanitary sewer with water. No disposal method should be used which would pose an environmental or human health threat including any which would contaminate ground or surface waters.
